**ORDER**

In accordance with the accompanying Memorandum Opinion, IT IS this **13th day of September, 2012**, by the U.S. District Court for the District of Maryland, hereby **ORDERED**:

1. That the Court **GRANTS** Plaintiffs' Motion for Temporary Preliminary Injunction (Doc. No. 19). Consequently, the Court hereby **ENJOINS**

- Defendants, and their officers, agents and employees, as well as all other persons acting in active concert or participation with them, **until October 31, 2012**, from implementing Section 11 of the STOCK Act to make financial disclosure forms of covered Executive Branch employees or the information contained in them available on the websites of any agency of the United States or otherwise available on the Internet;

- Defendants, and their officers, agents and employees, as well as all other persons acting in active concert or participation with them, **until October 31, 2012**, from, to the extent the accompanying Memorandum Opinion prohibits, requiring Executive Branch employees to submit financial disclosure information so long as such information is subject to Internet publication by federal agencies under the STOCK Act;

2. That, because Defendants likely will not suffer financial damage as a result of this injunction, Plaintiffs **SHALL NOT** be required to post a bond, and that this injunction **SHALL BE** effective immediately;

3. That the Court **STAYS** briefing until September 24, 2012. If this date passes and congressional action has not mooted the Parties' dispute, the Court directs the Parties to propose a briefing schedule for Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction; AND

4. That the Clerk transmit a copy of this Order to all counsel of record.
